## EXECUTIVE ORDER

1974 - 9

By virtue of the constitutional authority vested in me as Commander-in-Chief of the military forces of the State of Michigan and pursuant to Section 151, Act 150, Public Acts of 1967, and it appearing that a potential emergency may arise or has occurred as a result of an unprecedented snowstorm in the counties of Calhoun, Jackson, Lenawee, Livingston, Monroe, Washtenaw and Wayne in connection with which it has been determined that the assistance of the Michigan National Guard is required by civil authorities;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ADJUTANT GENERAL is hereby directed to order to active state service such units and individuals of the Michigan National Guard which in his discretion he deems appropriate after consultation with civil authorities. Units or individuals called to active state service will assist the civil authorities in connection with the potential emergency civil disturbance conditions and such active state service will terminate at such time as determined by the Adjutant General.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Michigan this first day of December in the Year of Our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Four and of the Commonwealth One Hundred Thirty-Eight.
