EXECUTIVE ORDER

1976-10

By virtue of the constitutional authority vested in me as Commander-in-Chief of the military forces of the State of Michigan and pursuant to Section 151, Act 150 of the Public Acts of 1967, and it appearing that an emergency has arisen in Schoolcraft County in connection with which it has been determined that the assistance of the Michigan National Guard is required by civil authorities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ADJUTANT GENERAL is hereby directed to order to active state service units and individuals of the Michigan National Guard which in his discretion he deems appropriate after consultation with civil authorities. Units or individuals called to active state service will terminate at such time as determined by the Adjutant General.
